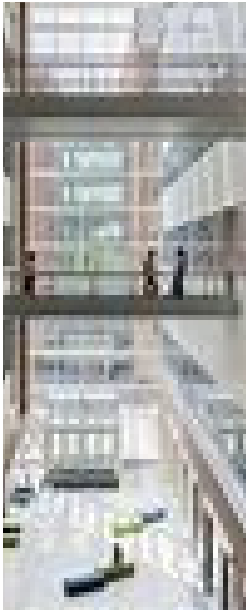


# Lab Safety Rockstar Checklist
